### **DRESS CODE**

Commencement is a formal ceremony. Proper attire and behavior are expected. Comfortable, business casual clothing is recommended for graduates. We also recommend that graduates wear shoes and clothing that are visible under their gown in dark colors that match the commencement gown.

**PLEASE DO NOT WEAR: SNEAKERS, BEACH SANDALS OR SHORTS**

**ALTERING OF ACADEMIC GOWNS IS ALSO NOT PERMITTED AND WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE ARENA**

### **SECURITY**

All graduates and their guests are asked to arrive early and kindly cooperate with the venue staff during the required security checks. Please follow instructions given by security personnel in order to make your entry into the venue as smooth as possible.

All guests and their bags will be inspected upon entering for the safety of those attending. No large bags or backpacks will be allowed into the venue.

### **PROHIBITED ITEMS**

To ensure the safety of all our guests, the JLKC conducts a search of all persons through a metal detector and bag check system prior to entering the facility. To expedite the process, please see below for prohibited items:

Bags Larger than 10"x7"x2" only exceptions include:

*Bags with Medical Equipment or Supplies*

*Clear Bags up to 12"x6"x12"*

*Diaper Bags: please have items inside gallon plastic bags to expedite the search*

*ALL bags are subject to search. Bags outside the policy may be checked in at our coat room for a fee.*

Strollers are not allowed upstairs to the theater level; they can be parked in an open area downstairs or checked at the coat room for a fee.

Air Horns/Noise Makers

Laser Pointers

Drones

Professional Cameras with a larger than 7-inch lens

Guns, Knives, or weapons of any kind

Signs or Posters

Animals, exceptions to service animals with paperwork

Outside Food or Drink

Glow Sticks

Clothing or Accessories with Spikes or Sharp Objects

Any items deemed to be a safety risk by the venue and local law enforcement
